My BUG BRICK

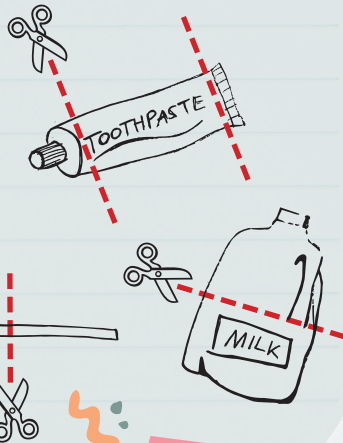
Materials List

- 1 x 6 egg box
- 2 x straw
- 1 x wide pen tube
- 1 x 4 pint milk carton
- 1 x empty tooth paste tube
- some fruit and veg offcuts
- some soil
- some leaves

Cut the materials as shown:

Make the different sized holes in the **EGG BOX** using the **PEN**.



Notes:

Use the pen to make the holes big enough to push the **STRAWS**, **PEN** and **TOOTH PASTE TUBE** through.

Notes:

1. Once cut, clean the inside of the tooth paste tube.
2. Keep the top of the milk carton.
3. Cut the straws different sizes.

With the items inserted through the holes, fill the egg box with **LEAVES**, **SOIL** and **FOOD OFFCUTS**.

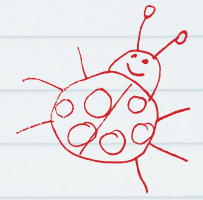
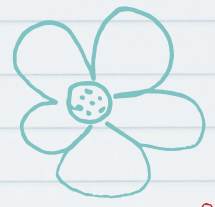
1. Pack the box tightly with the mixture.
2. Ensure the items are sticking out the end of the **EGG BOX** to allow the bugs to enter the bug brick.

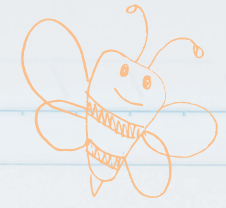
Close the **EGG BOX** and place it inside the **MILK CARTON**. Pack the carton with **SOIL** to make the brick and either bury it in the garden or stack many bricks together to make a bug hotel!
